We are seeing excellent progress for both the James Weir Memorial Agricultural/Technical Education Center and the new Kitchen.

Currently for the James Weir Memorial Agricultural/Technical Education Center the plumbing and electrical rough ins are complete and scheduled for inspection this week. Once the inspection is passed, durable plywood will be installed on the lower eight feet of the interior walls and drywall will be installed above the plywood. Coordinated efforts between the Agricultural Advisory Board and KNCC have taken place to ensure all necessary electrical requirements to run the shop equipment have been met. Window frames are also being installed this week. The window glass will be installed once it arrives. Overall progress is moving along nicely for the James Weir Memorial Agricultural/Technical Education Center.

In regards to the new Kitchen, KNCC completed the exterior wall framing and they started framing the roof on October 26. Roof framing is scheduled to be complete by November 3 and then framing of the interior walls will begin. Retaining walls for the North side of the project will begin soon.

It is very exciting to see the daily progress of the project. On Thursday, November 5, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. the Board of Directors will meet in a public meeting to discuss the Guaranteed Maximum Price for Phase 2 of the Comprehensive K-12 Facility.
