I am so proud to announce that we received occupancy approval for the James Weir Agricultural Science and Technology Center on January 14th and our students are now taking advantage of this wonderful educational space. We are planning to host a formal dedication ceremony in March to honor and thank the James Weir Foundation for their generous gift that helped make this facility possible.

In the new kitchen, crews have just finished completing the final connections for the electrical, mechanical and plumbing. The new kitchen equipment was delivered on January 18th and is now being installed. We eagerly anticipate receiving permission to use the kitchen by early February.

To make way for Phase II, the original Ag/Shop building is currently scheduled for demolition on February 1st. After demolition, KNCC will proceed with fill and foundation for Phase II which will include the new elementary wing.
