REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS

Superintendent Report

Superintendent Owens' report included appreciation to all certified and classified staff, congratulations to the class of 2019, an update on student enrollment, the development of the 2019-20 professional development schedule, the approval of the Measure 98 (Student Success) 19-20, 20-21 District Plan, staff mentorship program highlights, progress on the District Continuous Improvement Plans, an update on current job postings, a NCESD Special Education staffing update, gratitude to the Sherman County Sheriff's Office and the Multi-Agency Safety Committee, and announced that Back to School Night will be August 29, 2019.

K-12 Principal Report

Superintendent Owens explained that Principal Somnis is with the football team at camp so he was not able to be here tonight. He offered to answer any questions they may have.

Athletic Director Report

Superintendent Owens noted the success of the recent Basketball Tournament and that Champions Camp began today. Discussion took place on the hiring of coaches and assistant coaches. The process will continue to include the involvement of high school coaches and the hiring of middle school coaches.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS Social Science Textbook Adoption

Superintendent Owens explained that elementary and high school teachers were involved in the social science textbook selection process. The selected state approved textbooks have been in the library for a review period.

District Facility Signage

Superintendent Owens presented potential signage for the state championship signs on the outside west wall of the high school gym. Discussion took place about the redesign of the floor in the high school gymnasium. Superintendent Owens noted that two locations have been selected at each road entrance to the school for the installation of the safety committee approved signs. The signs will read the same as the signs placed at each door of the school in October of 2018. The sign will read, "Attention – Trained staff at our school have been certified and deputized to use any force necessary to protect students and staff." The board expressed their continued support of the program.

Superintendent Owens encouraged the board to think about meeting dates and start times for the 2019-20 board meetings. Chair Coelsch noted that there may be some need to be flexible in order to work with everyone's schedules.

Sherman County Credit Recovery Summer Program

Superintendent Owens explained an idea that was brought to him by staff member Tim Zacharias. There has been an increase in students that are deficient in credits and the idea is to start a free online summer credit recovery program. The program will be online but administered by a Sherman County School teacher. The pilot program will start with English and Math may be added if it is successful.

Current Posting/Office Structure

Superintendent Owens stated that both confidential secretary applicants were strong and each brought skills that would be beneficial to the position. It was decided to split the position and each will focus on duties that match their strongest skill set. For example, Kari Peters will be the Athletic Secretary and Tionie Kock will coordinate events. They each will continue in their current Instructional Assistant position for half of their day.
