Hello! It is the time of year when we traditionally conduct our student body elections to select our high school Associated Student Body Officers. These offices include: Class Presidents for the Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior classes; ASB President; ASB Vice President; ASB Treasurer (our only two-year term position); ASB Secretary; and ASB Advertisement Manager/PBIS Representative.

This year we are trying something new by moving our election date to the start of the 2020-2021 school year. We are hoping that this will allow us to conduct our election process in person. Also new, will be the addition of an interview for each candidate in front of a small interview committee. Interviews will be scored based on a scoring rubric that will be made available to each candidate ahead of time. Interview scores will be combined with the voting results of the student body to select our new officers. Continuing with our tradition, we plan for candidates to each deliver a brief campaign speech to their peers. We will then offer each Sherman high school student the opportunity to vote.
